"Deaths on the Rail"

An Old Man Killed at the Summit and a Child in Butte.

Two deaths on the railroad were reported yesterday. One was that of an old man named Thomas Armsden, who was run over near Summit Station by a westbound train. he was employed as flagman for some carpenters who were reaping the snowsheds, but just how it happened that he got in the way of the train nobody knows.

The other case was that of a girl named Silva, about 11 years of age, whose parents live in Nelson, Butte County. She was killed by the Marysville local northbound train on Wednesday evening, about four miles from Nelson.

It is supposed the girl was asleep on the track at the time the train struck her, as no other reason can be given by the trainmen for the accident. She had been out herding cattle for her father.

"Death of J C Wertsbaugher"

Chico, Cal., August 1st

J C Wertsbaugher, one of the proprietors of the Union Hotel, in Chico, died this afternoon at half-past five o'clock, of congestion of the liver, having only been sick three days. The deceased has been a prominent citizen of Butte county for over 25 years. He was six years Assessor of the County, and represented Butte in the Legislature of 1880-81. He was a prominent Odd Fellow, Past Grand of Chico Lodge, and one of the charter members of Chico Uniform Degree Camp No 2, under whose auspices he will be buried on Sunday morning.
